**Subject: Clarification on UCI Cyclo-Cross Equipment Regulations for the 2023-2024 cyclo-cross season**

Dear National Federations & UCI Teams,

The UCI would like to provide a clarification in relation to the communications sent on 27 July and 9 October 2023 regarding the use of UCI Approved Framesets within UCI sanctioned Cyclo-cross events.

For the **2023-2024 season**, framesets that do not display a UCI Frameset Label and are not published on the list of UCI Approved Framesets may continue to be used in Class 1, Class 2, Continental Championships and UCI Cyclo-cross World Cup events<sup>[1]</sup>.

For the purpose of clarity, the UCI wishes to emphasize that the use of UCI Approved Framesets will be mandatory at the 2024 UCI Cyclo-cross World Championships in Tábor, Czechia, for both the Men's and Women's Elite categories.

We trust that this guidance provides a clear understanding of the rules in place for the 2023-2024 UCI Cyclo-cross season. If you have any further questions or require additional information, please do not hesitate to contact the UCI Off-Road team.

<sup>[1]</sup>Article 1.3.002 of the UCI Regulations "The UCI shall not be liable for any consequences deriving from the choice of the equipment used by licence holders, nor for any defects it may have or its non-compliance. Framesets used must meet all relevant ISO quality and safety requirements for bicycles as well as any other standards applicable in the country of the event."
